Thank you for reminding your child of the appropriate behavior at school. They are getting a bit "Crazy" with Christmas coming!



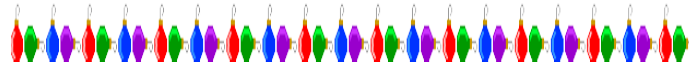
